Common name

Amarygia (Australia)

[Amaryllis x Brunsvigia](#) is an annual winter bulb with pink flowers in early Autumn, and it takes 10 to 15 years to flower. The flowers are trumpet shaped arranged in a umbelliform cyme inflorescence. It looks best in Autumn and Winter.



Growth

This plant has a shape and orientation.

The leaves are green in Winter. They are linear in shape.
